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## Old-world Krog Bar next for chef Kevin Rathbun

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Kevin Rathbun has been having so much fun with his namesake restaurant in Inman Park, he's decided to expand the bliss.

With partners Kirk Parks, Cliff Bramble and his wife, Melissa Rathbun, Rathbun has opened Krog Bar, a Mediterranean-themed wine establishment that will reside in the same industrial complex as his reservations-recommended eatery, Rathbun's.

Open all but Sunday nights, Krog Bar's menu will feature small plates and a descriptive list of dozens of French and Spanish wines.

The tapas menu has five parts: crudo, carne, tramezzini and formaggi, with choices ranging from bonita tuna and boquerones to aged prosciutto and bresola. Fresh gelato will satisfy diners' sweet teeth.

The Johnson Studio created the bar's old-world ambiance, with a room-length stand-up bar and six-foot-long communal tables. Custom-made iron racks, soft leather bar stools, cabernet-colored walls and a chocolate-brown ceiling complete the look.

Inside, the bar will seat 35 while another 25 can dine on the outdoor patio. The bar is set to open Oct. 3.
