The bar is owned by chef Kevin Rathbun, of the restaurant Rathbun's, along with partners Kirk Parks and Cliff Bramble. The bar has wines from Italy, Spain and France, and includes 20 by the glass. It also features Mediterranean-style cold plates divided into five categories — antipasti, crudo, carne, tramezzini and formaggi. Gelatos are created daily and coffee also is available. The tall, marble bar allows guests to stand and sip, while the 6-foot communal tables encourage mingling.
